

CUI is fully researching the impact and our responsibilities under the REACH legislation. At this time CUI has no knowledge that our products contain any substances of very high concern which need to be pre-registered. We are however largely dependent upon our diverse worldwide supply chain for relevant chemical composition information. CUI will continue to monitor our supply chain for continual compliance with the REACH directive.

REACH largely does not have an impact on CUI as REACH is intended to target raw materials/chemicals and not necessarily end products. Please see our brief REACH statement below:

- All CUI products meet the definition of an Article per the REACH directive (Article 3(3))
  - "Article means an object which during production is given a special shape, surface or design which determines its function to a greater degree than its chemical composition;" (REACH, Article 3(3)).
- Registration of substances in Articles is not required per REACH directive (Article 4) for the below reasons:
  - The substances present in CUI products are in quantities totaling less than 1 tonne per producer or importer per year;
  - The substances present in CUI products are not intended to be released under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use.
  - The substances present in CUI products is not above a concentration of 0.1% weight by weight (w/w).
  - Our products do not contain any substances of very high concern.
- The above information is to the best of our knowledge accurate. CUI will continue to monitor our supply chain for continual compliance with the REACH directive and will inform you of any changes.
